# 4. Verbs in connection with various sports

The three most common verbs we use in connection to various sports are

- play
- do
- go

Sometimes it is confusing when to use which, so let's take a look at some rules that can help.

## • PLAY

We use the verb play with sports we play with ball or with competitive games in which people are playing against each other.

### Example:

His brother plays football. - football is a ball sport

### • DO

We use the verb do for activities we do for recreation or for sports we do not play in teams and we do not use a ball.

### Example:

Ben does karate. - karate is sport that is not done in teams

• GO

We use the verb go for sports that end in 'ing'.

### Example:

He usually goes skiing every weekend during the winter.
