











## 6. Some useful expressions in connection with transport and travelling

<b>a journey</b>	A travel from one destination to another.
<b>to commute</b>	To travel to work or school on regular basis.
<b>a traffic jam</b>	A situation where there are so many cars, buses, and other means of transport that the traffic stops moving or moves slowly.
<b>a railway station</b>	A station where you can get on or off a train.
<b>a single ticket</b>	A ticket you get when you pay for a one-way journey to somewhere.
<b>a return ticket</b>	A ticket you get when you pay for a journey to one destination and back.
<b>a season ticket</b>	Usually a bus or a train ticket where you can go by bus or train every day for a month, or a year.
<b>a passenger</b>	A traveller riding in a vehicle but not operating it
<b>a rush hour</b>	It usually happens at the beginning and end of the working day when many people are traveling to or from work or school.
<b>a pedestrian</b>	A person who travels on foot.
