JOB	DEFINITION
a secretary	A person who writes letters, e-mails, schedules appointments, usually for her/his manager/director.
a receptionist	A person who greets people who have appointments at the office, answer the phones and similar.
a director	A person who is in charge of something, usually of a company, organization and similar.
an assistant	A person who helps at particular work, usually to somebody superior to him / her.

a psychiatrist	A medical practitioner specializing in the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness.
a dentist	A person who is qualified to treat diseases and other conditions that affect the teeth and gums.
a pharmacist	A person who is qualified to prepare and dispense medicinal drugs.
a vet	A person who treats ill animals.
a nurse	A person who gives medical and other attention to an ill person and assists doctors.
a paramedic	A person trained to give emergency medical care to people.

a mentor	A person who gives a younger or less experienced person help and advice.
a counsellor	A person who offers guidance on personal or psychological problems to students.
a mathematics teacher	A teacher who teaches Maths.
an English teacher	A teacher who teaches English.
a history teacher	A teacher who teaches History.
a music teacher	A teacher who teaches music.

an actress	A female person who performs in movies, theatre plays...
a writer	A person who writes novels, short stories, books...
a poet	A person who writes poems.
a photographer	A person who takes photos for a hobby or his profession.
a painter	A person who paints pieces of art, usually paintings.

a janitor	A person who takes care of a building.
